N-TISE WORKSHOP (Hybrid)

Dear all,

On **March 26 and 27, 2026** the Network for Teaching Indigenous Studies in Europe will have its third in-person workshop.

The conversation about setting up a Network for Teaching Indigenous Studies in Europe started in 2022. Since then, it has led to several online discussions and two hybrid events addressing the specific challenges of teaching this field in a European context, whether by Indigenous or non-Indigenous scholars.

We think of the N-TISE workshop as an opportunity to get acquainted and as an opportunity to share and discuss our teaching practices in Indigenous Studies. Our goals include:

- 1) to develop a critical understanding of what it means to teach Indigenous Studies in Europe, and address the inherent difficulties, responsibilities and opportunities;
- 2) to support and inspire each other in our teaching of Indigenous Studies in Europe through the sharing of teaching materials, syllabi, and/or other materials, and/or through focused workshops;
- 3) to have a website as well as a listserv that we can use to inform each other of teaching materials, guest lectures, and opportunities;
- 4) to discuss ways to obtain funding.

Call for Presentations

For the event in March 2026, we are looking for **contributors to give a 30-minute presentation** on their teaching practice.

This can be a presentation of a full course that you teach and the challenges attendant on that course; a presentation on a single class on an Indigenous topic, for instance in the context of a non-Indigenous overview course; an event or field trip that you organized for students, etc.
